Dr. (Alice) Suzanne Jackson Temples Kelly was born July 1, 1926 in New Brighton, PA and passed away Monday, March 14, 2022. Suzanne received her Doctor of Podiatric Medicine in 1948 from the College of Podiatric Medicine in Cleveland, Ohio. She set up her own practice in New Brighton, PA which she ran successfully for 12 years until she moved to Virginia. Suzanne married Ralph B. Temples in 1952. They relocated to Falls Church, VA and in 1963 moved to Homestead, FL with their three children. Her husband, Ralph, passed away in 1967. She then became a substitute teacher which allowed her the flexibility to raise her three young children. In 1986, Suzanne married Charles W. Kelly. In 2001, Charles passed away. In 2007, Suzanne relocated to Peachtree City, GA.

Suzanne will always be remembered for her incredible wit and “Suzanneisms.” She was an active member in the community serving on various boards and organizations.
