



## Arthur Alston Morrison

October 19, 1929 - February 11, 2016

Mr. Arthur Alston Morrison III of Fairburn passed away February 11, 2016. Born in Savannah, Ga. on October 19, 1929, he graduated from Savannah High School, UGA and Emory Law School. After several years of service as an officer in the U.S. Navy, he practiced law for many years in Forest Park. He was the founding member of the Clayton County Rotary Club, a member of the Forest Park Masonic Lodge #399 (and the Shriners International, Yaarab Shriners) and the St. Andrews Society of Savannah. With a deep love of music, his primary retirement avocation was playing the trombone in the Southernaires Swing Band and the Yaarab Shrine Band. In retirement he was also very active in his church, St. Francis Anglican. He was preceded in death by his wife, Beverley Almand Morrison and sister, Dr. Leotus Morrison of Harrisonburg, VA.
