Benjamin "Ben" Boyce Pace, born on November 12, 1962, passed away on April 12, 2026, at the age of 63. He dedicated his life to the service and protection of others through a distinguished career in law enforcement spanning four decades.

Ben began his career as a volunteer firefighter and EMT, where he demonstrated his commitment to public safety and care for those in need. 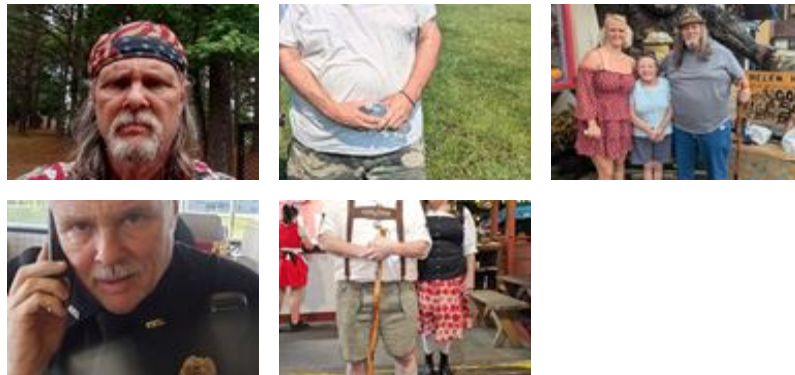
