



## Betty Sue Simpson Privett

June 8, 1932 - August 17, 2024

Betty Sue Simpson Privett, born June 8, 1932, in Union City, Georgia, passed away peacefully on August 17, 2024, in Newnan, Georgia, at the age of 92. She leaves behind a legacy of love, generosity, and unwavering support for her family and community.

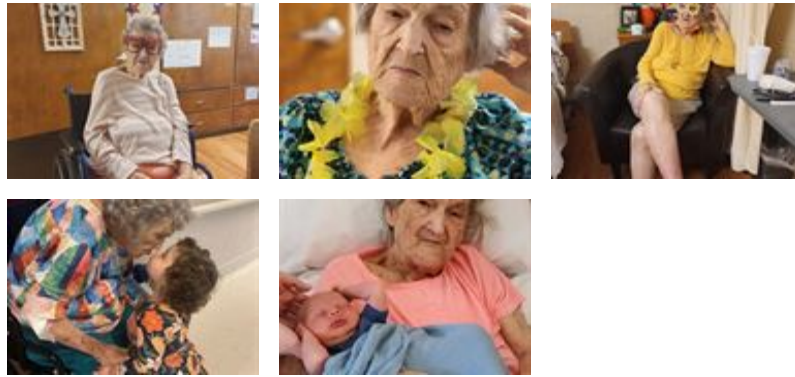
