Biography

Carolyn J. Cardin age 74, passed away January 19, 2014 peacefully at her home in Toccoa GA.

Born in Fairburn GA July 17, 1939, Mrs. Cardin was retired as an employee of

the State of Georgia for 25 years but never retired from being a Mother, Grandmother, Great-Grandmother, daughter, sister, and beloved friend to people all over the world. Mrs. Cardin served each church where her husband Rev. Arthur Cardin pastored at Friendship Baptist Church, Hiawassee GA; Haddock Baptist Church, Haddock, GA; First Baptist Church, Grantville GA; Cross Roads Baptist Church, Carnesville GA; Mt. Olive Baptist Church, East Point GA and First Baptist Church, Bloomingdale GA. She served as a role model for other pastor's wives. She taught Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, was active in the WMU, played the piano, and organized countless meals and receptions to honor other people. Her love of mission work was evidenced by her many mission trips that she and her husband organized to many different places in the world, including Brazil and the Middle East. She worked in Thailand most recently where she taught "southern" conversational English at the Baptist Student center in Bangkok. Mrs. Cardin was a regional coordinator for Operation Christmas Child, a mission of Samaritan's Purse. She sought to make Christmas special to children world-wide just like she made Christmas special for her own family and friends. She graduated from Truett-McConnell College in Cleveland GA.

She was preceded in death by her father Howard Jenkins and her husband Rev. Arthur E. Cardin.
