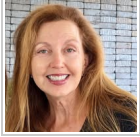

“ When I first met CECIL he was working hard at wooing my beautiful AUNT MARTHA, this was probably 1968 or 69 when I was about 10 years old. Cecil would come over on the weekends with his guitar and sheet music and song books, and he would play and she would sing.

The songs were the beautiful folk songs of the day – Peter Paul & Mary LEAVING ON A JET PLANE and Janis Joplin ME and MY BOBBY McGEE. I loved those Saturday afternoons when Cecil would come over.

He was very talented on the guitar, and Martha (to this day) has a beautiful singing voice. But me, well, I was completely tone deaf. I remember noticing at an early age, how Cecil showed such kindness to me when he would visit, like I was a “real person” and not just an annoying chubby little girl.
