Charles Louis Mundy, Jr., affectionately known as Louis, passed away peacefully on June 3, 2026, at the age of 84. Born on November 8, 1941 at Crawford Long Hospital, he considered himself a true Atlantan, his formative years spent in Cascade Heights.

His love of music was nurtured during his elementary and high school years. He played both the piano and organ and was in the percussion section of the West End Elementary Band and the Southwest High School Band. Throughout his lifetime he created warm memories of worshipping and serving in the music programs of his church.

He attended Emory University for two years before graduating from the University of Georgia School of Pharmacy. Louis 100% bled red and black. Upon graduation from Pharmacy School Louis officially entered the family business, the Mundy Drug Company, where he had unofficially worked since he was seven years old. He always said you weren't a real pharmacist if you didn't know how to make a lime sour and a good milkshake. There were several different locations of the Mundy Drug Company, but his fondest memories were of Mundy's in Tyrone where he lovingly served the community with care and commitment for many years. His work as a pharmacist was not just a profession—it was a true calling. He was deeply respected by all who

knew him.

Louis is survived by his wife of 61 years, Carey Vinzant Mundy, daughters Janie Annette Mundy and Susan Mundy Rouse and her husband, Keith, and four granddaughters: Erica, Maria, Kate and Sarah. He is also survived by his sister, Sandra Egle, and her husband Jim.

A funeral service to honor and celebrate Louis's life will be held on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, at 11:00 a.m. at the Chapel of Parrott Funeral Home.
