



Christina Knox Asmus Abell

April 16, 1952 - February 1, 2021

CHRISTINA KNOX ASMUS ABELL passed away on February 1, 2021 in Peachtree City, GA, following a brief illness. Chris was born April 16, 1952 in Carlisle, PA, to Grover W. and Sallie Mae Holman Asmus. She was the granddaughter of Julian Knox and Margaret Steagall Holman of Ozark, AL, and Grover E. and Josephine Asmus of Bergen, NJ.

She grew up in Montgomery, AL, and attended the University of Alabama before graduating from Auburn University at Montgomery with a Bachelor of Arts in English and a double minor in Accounting and Business Management. In 1991, she married Dr. John Bruce Abell of Springfield, KY. They had two sons, Jonathan and Collin, and were later divorced. She was an active member of St. John's Episcopal Church in Montgomery, until moving to Peachtree City, when she became an active member of St. Andrew's in the Pines Episcopal Church. Chris was devoted to raising and supporting her sons. She had shining eyes, a bright smile, and a remarkable sense of humor.
