Christine Stephens Bomar Kelley of Union City, GA, passed away September 10, 2014 at the age of 95. She was the oldest daughter of Osby C. and Ora Long Stephens of Fairburn, Georgia.

She is preceded in death by husband Archie Columbus Bomar of Palmetto to whom she was married for 31 years, and Alvin Willis Kelley of Goodwater, AL whom she was married to for 17 years, and her sister Mary Lynn Stephens Thomas of Fairburn.

Upon marriage to Archie, she joined Ramah Baptist Church in Palmetto where they were faithful members of the choir. "Miss Christine" also found much joy in working with the children and youth of Ramah. At the time of her death, she had been a member of Ramah for 76 years.

Christine was always devoted to her music ministry. It was through the love of gospel music that she met and married Alvin Kelley. Together, they travelled the Southeast attending and leading gospel singing conventions where she joyfully spent countless hours accompanying singers as the organist or pianist. When unable to travel, she would eagerly treat family and friends to "concerts" in her home.
