Dennis Ray Farr of Sharpsburg passed away on Saturday, November 23, 2024. Dennis was born on June 17, 1953 in Newnan. He was the son of the late George (Bud) Ray Farr and Joy Horsley Farr. He was a graduate of Campbell High School in Fairburn and attended The University of Georgia strengthening his love for the Bulldogs. Dennis grew up as a member of Ramah Baptist Church where he was baptized. He later served as a deacon at Palmetto Baptist Church and most recently attended Crossroads Church. Dennis retired from Fulton County Schools, where he was Lead Supply Person for Warehouse Services.

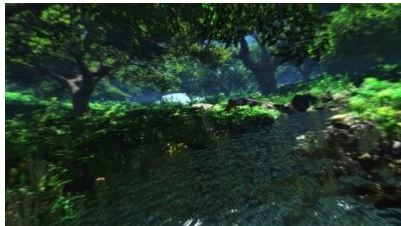

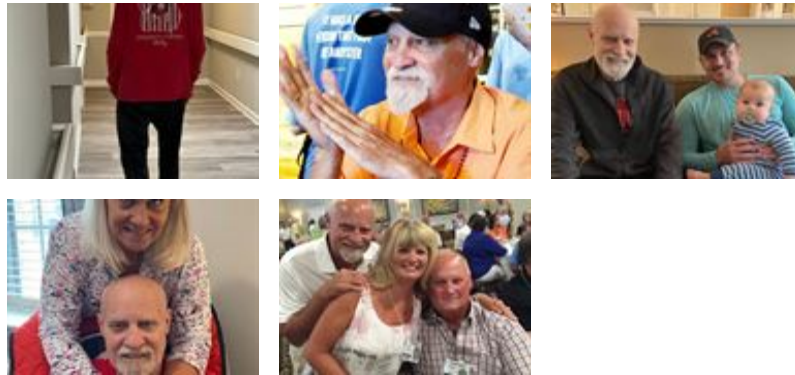
