Dr. Tucker was a respected teacher at Campbell High School and a beloved pharmacist in Fairburn and the South Fulton Community for many years at Amoss Pharmacy. He was a 1947 graduate of the University of Georgia where he received his degree in Agricultural Science. He taught agriculture at Campbell High School for nine years. He also attended and graduated from the Southern School of Pharmacy in 1962.
