Dr. Elizabeth (Betty) Caldwell Hamil, a lifelong resident of Palmetto, passed away

August 22, 2006 at Fayette Piedmont Hospital. She is survived by her devoted husband, Bobby F. Hamil. Betty Hamil graduated from Campbell High School in 1939 and then graduated from Mercer University in 1942. She completed graduate work at Southern Baptist Seminary and went on to receive her Ph. D at The University of Georgia. Her deep love of children and her pervasive belief in public education led her to a career of forty years with Fulton County Schools. She began as a teacher and became a director of Curriculum where she inspired countless teachers in creative approaches to learning. Dr. Hamil never waivered in her devotion to young people and her belief in their ability to achieve success through education. In retirement, Betty Hamil and her husband served as volunteer teaching missionaries through numerous trips to Africa, Russia and China. She was an active member of Flat Creek Baptist Church. She was very knowledgeable about the Bible and used her teaching skills to serve the Lord throughout her life. She was preceded in death by her beloved son Roger Corley and her brother Jimmy (Son) Caldwell, Jr. She is survived by daughter-in-law Ann Corley, granddaughter Kim (Chris) Pulliam and grandson Glenn (Joan) Corley; great grandchildren Kelley and Greg Pulliam. Funeral services will be held Thursday, August 24, 2006 at 11 o'clock at Flat Creek Baptist Church with remains placed in state at 10 o'clock.
