After the children were in school she was employed by the library system of Fairburn and served in various capacities including Children's Librarian. She was esteemed by many of the Fairburn school children for the help she provided in their school assignments. She was known, knew, and loved by most all of the Library's patrons.

She was a member of the Fairburn United Methodist Church and Longino Fellowship Sunday School Class since 1984 until the time of her death, and served in various capacities and committees of the church during this period.

After eleven years of widowhood, she married Walter Cook in 1994. They moved to Sharpsburg soon after ,where she remained for the balance of her life.
