



Ella Maria Heimbeck Hendrix

November 11, 1936 - May 18, 2026

Ella Maria Heimbeck Hendrix, born on November 11, 1936, in Schweinfurt, Germany, passed away peacefully on May 18, 2026, at the age of 89. A devoted homemaker and caregiver, she dedicated much of her life to nurturing others, both within her family and through her work in church.

Ella was a woman of remarkable independence and strength. She took great pride in maintaining her home, where she resided for 47 years before moving to Pike Manor Residential Living for the last eight months of her life. Her love for the outdoors was evident in her enjoyment of yard work, mowing her own grass and gardening, and she found joy in watching the birds that visited her.

In the 1960s, Ella became a U.S. citizen, having met her beloved husband, Frankie Leon Hendrix, during his service in Germany. Together, they built a life filled with love and family. A faithful member of Bethlehem Baptist Church in Fairburn, GA, Ella served diligently in the nursery, participated in the Good News Club, and was an active member of the senior club, The Classics. Her commitment to her faith and community was unwavering.
