Biography

Mr Ernie Kennemore Jr. of Fayetteville Georgia went to be with Jesus on

Friday March 20th 2015. He was born on February 27th 1954 in Hapeville Ga. He met this girl named Sherry at age 14, she became his bride in January of 1973. In 1977 they welcomed their first son and 18 months later their only daughter and finally 15 months later their youngest son. At the age of 17 he started his aviation career at Barfield Instrument. While supporting his family of 5 he worked his way up the ladder for several years and in 1986 he left Barfield to start his own aviation business and Precision Avionics and Instruments (PAI) was Born. He put everything he had into his new company and grew it into a multi-million dollar business that he sold in 2000. In 2002 he bought a small company and has since grown Aviation Enterprises LLC (AEL) into the company it is today. He has assisted many other companies and young entrepreneurs with his abundance of business knowledge and financial investments. Aviation was in his blood as he not only loved the business but he also obtained his pilot license in the late 1970's. This was a major accomplishment for a man who was afraid of heights but loved to fly. Ernie was a very caring man who never met a stranger. He treated everyone he met equally whether they be the CEO of a successful company or the janitor. He was an avid hunter and loved to be outdoors. He enjoyed several hunting adventures all over the country. He liked to hunt any and all sorts of game from Turkey and Deer to Elk and wild Boar. He had so many hunting buddies who were more like brothers than friends.
