Mr. Eugene Garner passed away August 15, 2017. Eugene H. Garner, Daddy, Papaw - worked hard all of his life. He worked for over thirty years in Civil Service for the US Air Force as a quality control inspector. A job that required him to move his family frequently. Beginning at Warner Robbins AFB, then to Marietta,

Roswell, New Mexico, to Garrison , Dakota, to Kenmare, North Dakota then to Cape Kennedy, making their home in Titusville, Fl. In 1964.

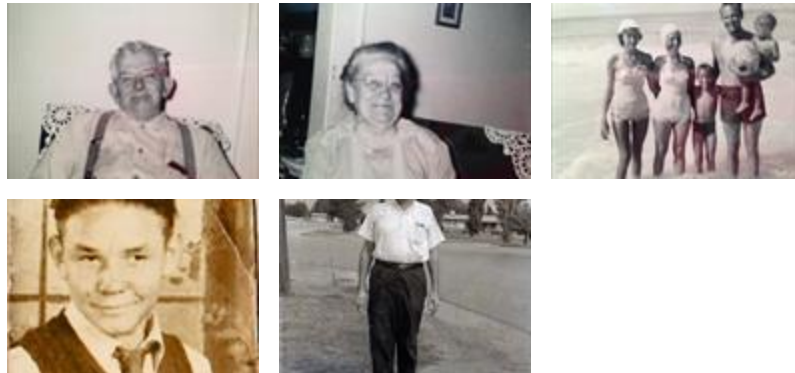
