April 17, 1936 - September 4, 2024

With heavy hearts, we announce the passing of Mr. Fay K. Shubert, who departed this world on September 4, 2024, in Newnan, GA, at the age of 88. Born on April 17, 1936, in Fayette County, Georgia, Fay lived a full and inspirational life marked by hard work, dedication, and an unwavering gentle spirit.

Fay's journey began in farming where he developed his work ethic from a very young age. As a teenager, he worked at a Cotton Mill inspecting threads, and as he grew older, he took on the role of an Equipment Operator at a Quarry. For a time he worked in the warehouse at S & H Green Stamps. His career truly flourished when he joined Delta Airlines, where he dedicated 28 years as a brilliant and meticulous aircraft mechanic. Fay had an innate ability to fix anything, even the unfixable, and his detail-oriented nature was admired by all who knew him.

A member of the Masons Tyrone Lodge, Fay's character was defined by quiet strength and soft-spoken wisdom. To describe him in one word would be "gentle." He was a great teacher, always willing to share his knowledge and skills with others. His tractor was his happy place, and his love for mechanics was evident in everything he did.

His wife, Evelyn Shubert, was the love of his life, and their bond was unshakeable for the 64 years they shared. The couple was inseparable since the day they met, and her passing just five and a half months ago left a poignant void in his life. Now, they are reunited in eternity. Fay was also

preceded in death by his brother, Young Shubert. He is survived by his loving daughter, Diane Benzon and her husband, Jeff, along with many cherished nieces and nephews.
