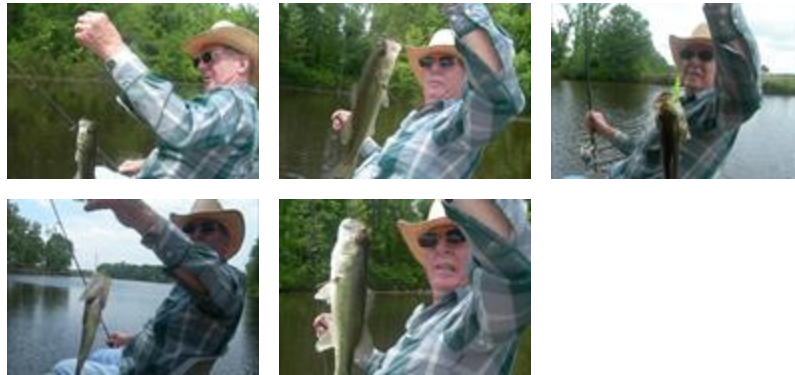

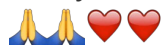
He loved his animals, his wife, kids, and grandkids deeply. He was a special man who made a lasting impact on my life, and he will be sorely missed.

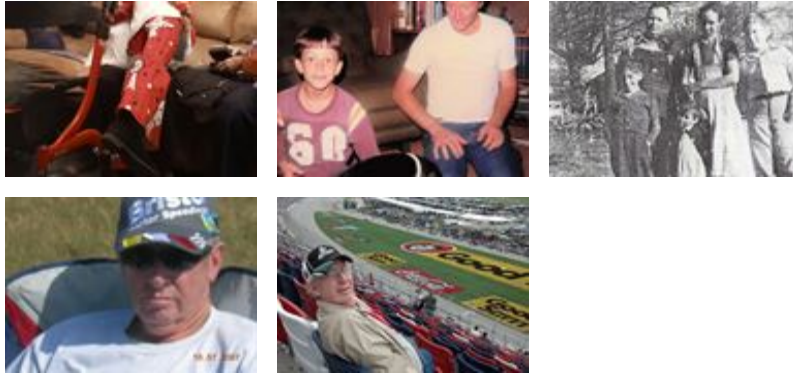
