Mr. Gary Allen Whitlock, age 73, of Palmetto, passed away Wednesday, August 10, 2022. He was born January 3, 1949 to Harold and Dorothy Whitlock. Gary served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War. He was employed with the United States Postal Service in Palmetto, GA for 34 years. 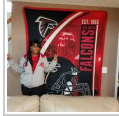

“ After he served in the Army during the Viet Nam conflict Gary Whitlock was my second roommate, and my friend. It was a rough time for the both of us. Gary was a good man. He could be acerbic, but always had that smile that you see in the picture. We would travel to Hapeville after work to eat at Thomas' restaurant. I was a slow eater but Gary really 'wolfed it down', so to speak. Then he would smoke a cigarette before polishing off his dessert, and then firing up another cig. He usually smoked three while waiting for me to finish... Gary had a brother and they shared a basement apartment on West Rugby Avenue, near a soda fountain, 'Pup's', where we could go after school and drink a milkshake and talk. Before being drafted Gary was an outgoing, gregarious guy, but after returning from Viet Nam his personality had changed completely. He did not talk about his experience in 'Nam often, but when he did it was like the flood gates opened. I have never, ever discussed anything Gary said about his experience 'over there', and never will, not that he swore me to secrecy or anything, but because he talked to me knowing I would keep it to myself. Gary was one of, if not the most strident fans of the 1968 College Park Baseball team, and watched many, if not most of our games. During the pandemic Susan 'Bells' Bailey, who attended Hapeville HS, and I reacquainted ourselves and talked on the phone several times. One day she sent me a picture of Gary, who had dropped by to visit earlier. We talked about getting some of the old gang together and going to the 'new & improved' Chic-Fil-A Dwarf House in Hapeville, and Gary was at the top of the list. I have been so looking forward to the end of the pandemic and getting together again with some of my classmates, and now Gary is gone, but he will never be forgotten. It has been nice reading the words left here by those who knew Gary later in life as it appears he found a way to overcome his difficulties and return to being the life of the party once again. This was received from Keith James, The Pitcher on the CPHS squad, after I notified him of the death of our friend:

"Gary was the first friend I had when I moved to Cp in 1961 . We attended Longino Elementary in the 7th grade . Went to his house

many times .

*When Jimmy Pike and Gary quit playing sports after their sophomore year , that hurt our baseball & football program .
Loved ole Gary!"*

I have included this because men who are not homosexual usually do not say they "loved" another man, but I, too, loved the guy. Rest in peace, roomie.

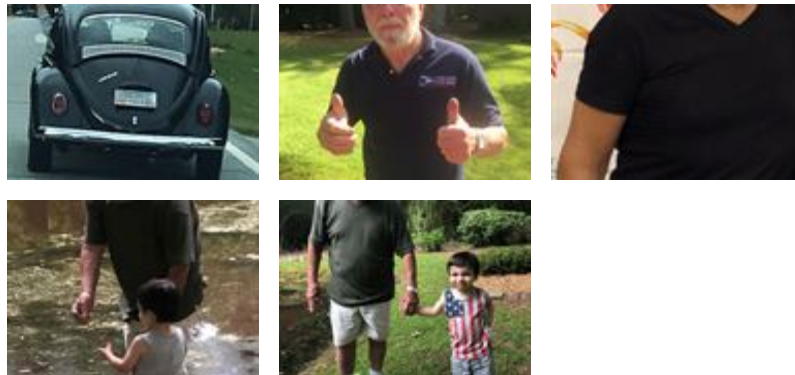
