George Augustus Martin, Sr., 94, of Sharpsburg, Georgia died peacefully in his sleep on December 22, 2022. A celebration of George's life will be held on Monday, June 19th at 10:30 AM at the Go Church, 3935 GA-34 E, Sharpsburg, GA.

George was born in Pennsdale, Pennsylvania on December 10, 1928, the son of Earl J. and Mae Martin. George was active in Special Olympics for many years and was a devoted husband and father. He was a friend to everyone, even people who did not like his beloved Minnesota Vikings. He was a hard worker, well-liked in every position he was ever involved in and never had a bad word to say about anyone. A gentleman from "The Greatest Generation."
