



Mr. Harry McCoy Cook

November 6, 1922 - April 3, 2017

Harry McCoy Cook passed away from natural causes on April 3, 2017. After battling a heart condition for some time, he died in his sleep while a patient at Eastside Medical Center in Snellville, Georgia.

Mr. Cook was born in Madison County, Tennessee, on November 6, 1922. He grew up in Memphis and married his childhood sweetheart, Mary Rose Dougan, on September 16, 1946. His loving wife predeceased him in 2004.

After Memphis, Mr. Cook and his family lived in East Point, Georgia and Bradenton, Florida, before returning to the Clifftondale area in the 1970s. Mr. Cook soon joined the First Baptist Church of Clifftondale, where he remained a staunch member of the congregation until just before his passing.

Throughout his life, Mr. Cook was a devoted husband and father. He leaves three sons and their families: John and his wife Gail, Mark and his wife Pam, and Gary and his wife Lynn, along with their children Rebekah, Matthew and Abigail. He will rest alongside his wife at Forest Lawn Cemetery in College Park.
