Helen Stephens Steed, born on May 28, 1926, in Fairburn, GA, passed away peacefully on August 4, 2024, in Union City, GA, at the age of 98.

A devoted wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and great-great-grandmother, Helen was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Frank Steed, whom she married on August 21, 1948. She was also preceded in death by her sisters, Christine Kelly and Mary Lynn Thomas.

Helen's professional journey included a six-year tenure at the Southern Bell Telephone Company in Atlanta, followed by three years of dedicated service in the order office at Sears Roebuck in East Point. She later found her true calling as a supply school teacher, imparting knowledge and guidance to students in the Fulton County School Systems for 14 rewarding years.

Services to honor Helen's life will be held on Friday, August 9, 2024, at 1 o'clock in the Chapel of Parrott Funeral Home with Rev. Daniel DeJong officiating. Interment will follow at Holly Hill Memorial Park. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service on Friday.

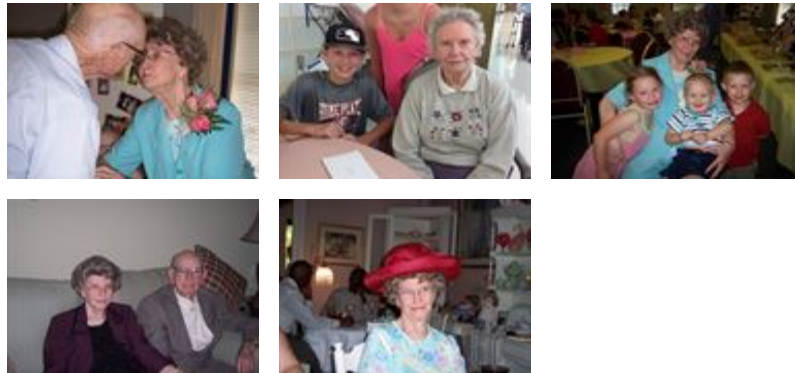

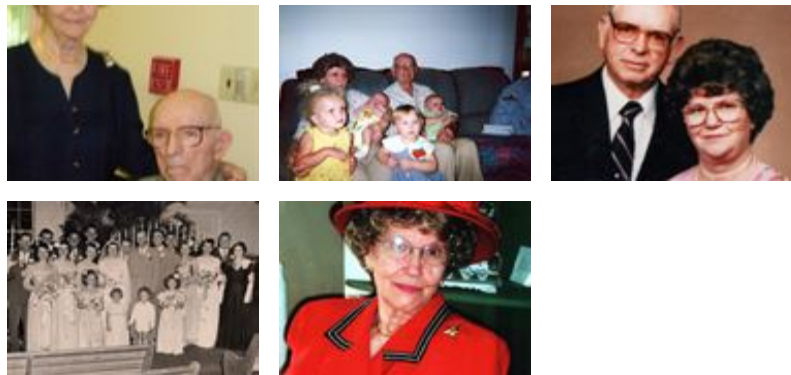
