James Clifford Fincher, Jr., of Lawrenceville died on December 22, 2011. He was born December 25, 1922 in Fannin Co., GA. He was the son of the late James

Clifford and Belle Chapman Fincher, Sr. He was a devout Christian; he loved the Lord and was a Deacon at Gloster Baptist Church in Lawrenceville, GA. All his life he loved singing and playing different musical instruments. He began lessons on the fiddle at eight years of age while living in Akron, Ohio. He especially loved his guitar and keyboard and earlier in life he played and also called for square dances at the Sports Arena in Atlanta, GA. War Department for participating in work essential to the production of the Atomic Bomb, thereby contributing to the successful conclusion of World War II. Although unable to serve in the Army because of childhood polio he was still able to do his part for his country. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Dorothy Ruth Fincher (1992), brothers Roy and Jackie, sister, Edna Fagan and son in law Anton D' Allen.
