Janis Kay Smith Green, 69, of Newnan, Georgia, died peacefully on March 20, 2024.

Janis was born on September 22, 1954, in Glendale, Arizona. She graduated from Campbell High School in 1972, then attended the University of West Georgia, earning both her Bachelors and Masters Degrees in Education. She taught for 34 years at Fayetteville County High School, influencing many through her roles as teacher, counselor, mentor, coach and friend. Her most cherished role, though, was being an aunt to her two nephews.

Janis always had a smile and a kind word for everyone she met. She could be playful one minute, and fall into a deep philosophical conversation in the next. Spending time with loved ones was her top priority. She also enjoyed traveling with friends to the Women's College World Series and following Atlanta and University of Georgia sports.

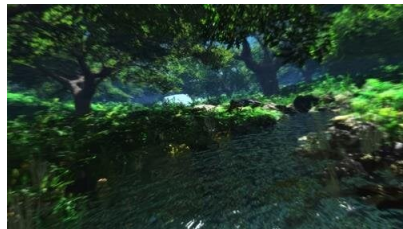
