Jerry Norman Hart age 83 a resident of Peachtree City, Georgia passed away in his home after a brief illness. He is survived by his wife Sondra, their 3 children and 5 grandchildren.

Jerry was born in Geary, Oklahoma and was son of Urne and Opal Hart. He was a talented athlete who played football and wrestled for Geary High School and went on to wrestle for Oklahoma State University. Jerry had a strong appreciation for his country and those that fought to preserve our freedoms. Jerry served in the Army and was stationed in Fort Benning.
