December 1, 1927 - June 18, 2019

Jewell Elaine Minor Andrews, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, great, great grandmother, sister, sister-in-law, mother-in-law, aunt and friend passed away June 18 at the age of 91. Jewell lived her life well, she loved well and she was well loved.

Born on December 1, 1927 in East Point, GA, Jewell Elaine Minor was the sixth-born child of John Hillyer. and Lavicia Gertrude Minor's seven children, all of whom predeceased Jewell. Jewell was also predeceased by her first-born daughter Judy Elaine Andrews Price.

Jewell married her childhood sweetheart, Robert Sanford Andrews III on June 3, 1947. Jewell and Bob's extraordinary life together spanned seven decades and they felt most grateful to celebrate their 70th wedding anniversary in June of 2017 with their extended family and friends, and later they celebrated 71 years of marriage prior to Bob's passing in August of 2018.

As Jewell's family was the center of her life, her faith was the center of her heart. Beginning her Christian journey at East Point Baptist Church, Jewell developed and maintained friendships which lasted a lifetime. Many of these treasured friends were part of a monthly Supper Club which Jewell and Bob looked forward to and treasured its members for many decades.

When Jewell and Bob moved to Tyrone, GA in 1972, they became active members of Flat Creek Baptist Church. Jewell lived her authentic faith by being the hands and feet of Christ by serving others whenever a need arose or by volunteering to cook in the church kitchen. Jewell implemented her

catering skills joyfully at her church or graciously in her home entertaining her family and friends. She was an extraordinary hostess whose hobby was cooking for her family and friends.

As a graduate of East Point's Russell High School and a mother of three, Jewell successfully pursued and obtained a Teaching Certificate from the University of Georgia's Extension Service. Jewell used her certificate and her innate love of teaching to become a kindergarten teacher. Jewell's final professional achievement was her 22-year career at the Chevrolet/General Motors Lakewood plant as an Employee Representative in GM's Personnel Department. This was the perfect position for someone who genuinely loved people and desired to assist them with personal concerns.

In her later years, Jewell remained dedicated to serving others by volunteering at both South Fulton Hospital and Piedmont Fayette Hospital. She actively participated in the GM Lakewood Retirees' Club Luncheons. Her dreams of travel came true when she and Bob visited Europe, Canada, Hawaii and travelled to many cities in the USA.

Jewell is survived by her son Robert Sanford Andrews IV (Bonnie) and her daughter Catherine "Kathy" Andrews McNulty (Marty, who predeceased Jewell in February, 1918). Jewell's living legacy includes grandchildren: Kelly Price Massey (Steve), Richard Andrews Price, Matthew Bryan Andrews, Jennifer Andrews Whitson (Beau), Brent Adam Crockett (Kelly) and Jeffrey Scott Crockett (Ashley), eleven great grandchildren, and, a great, great grandchild, sisters-in-law, brothers-in-law, cousins, nieces and nephews.

The passage Matthew 25:28 is applicable to Jewell and her life: "Well done, good and faithful servant".

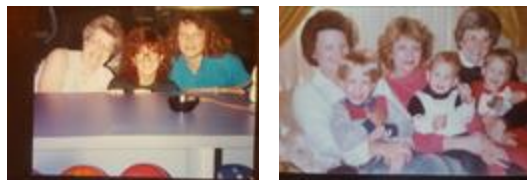
