Mr. Joe Jackson, age 94, of Fairburn, passed away Sunday, April 26, 2020. He is survived by his wife, Nancy Rutledge Jackson; children, David Childs and his wife, Kathleen, Deborah Wilson and her husband, Ken, Mark Childs, and Timothy Childs; grandchildren, Kristina, Amanda, Ryan, Tyler, Caleb, and Dustin; great grandchildren, Mya, Kaden, and Harley. Joe B. Jackson grew up in Newnan Ga. He enlisted in the U.S. Coast Guard at the start of WWII and was a signal man where his ship had to keep out enemy submarines off the eastern sea board. After the war he then began a long history in law enforcement. He was a correction officer at the Federal prison in Atlanta and then a Georgia State Patrol officer. From there he moved on to be a Deputy U.S. Marshall after that he became Warden and Assistant Warden at two different Georgia prisons. Joe's last job was being a polygraph examiner in which he worked into his 80's. Joe was an avid reader of history and political books and probably read a thousand books during his lifetime. 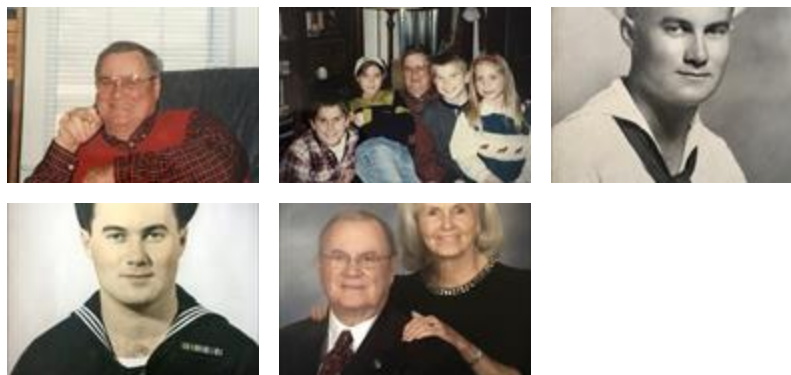
