John Charles Ramm, born on January 22, 1947, passed away on September 21, 2024, in Fayetteville, GA, at the age of 77—a life measured not just in years but in adventures, wit, and an unwavering dedication to those he loved.

John's career was a high-flying success. He spent 30 years as a ground school instructor with Pan Am, which later became Delta Airlines. But John's love for aviation didn't stop there. He initially earned his wings in the United States Air Force, where he trained as a pilot in Texas and became a B52 pilot at Griffiss Air Force Base. His journey then took him to Germany as a maintenance commander before finally landing at Nellis Air Force Base in Las Vegas, where he retired in 1990.

Whether it was hunting, fishing, or volunteering at Evergreen Church, John brought his dry wit and can-do spirit to everything he did.
