Joyce traveled extensively for pleasure and with mission groups. Some of her travels include England, Scotland, Ireland, France, Spain, Portugal, Italy and all through the Mediterranean including Morocco and other points of interest. In ____ she traveled to Russia for a two-week mission trip to an orphanage in Moscow. She was also a member of Flat Creek Baptist Church.

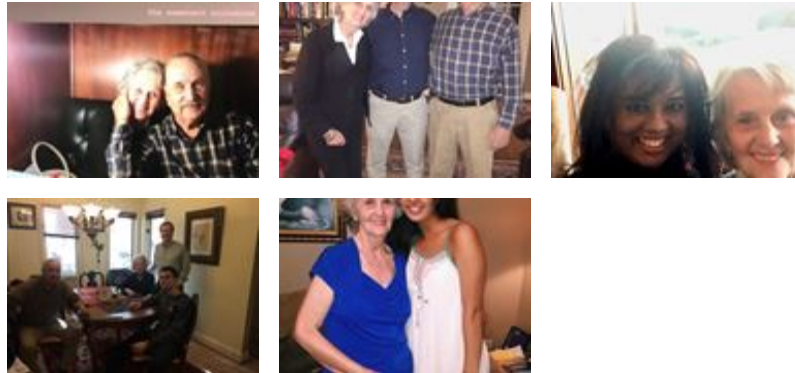

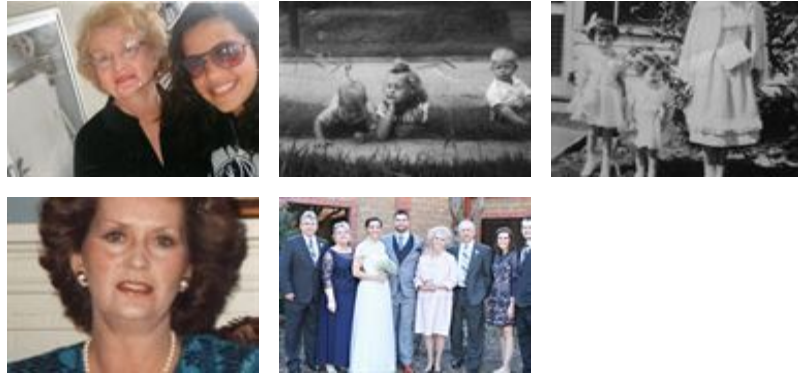
