Through the church, they volunteered at Southwest Christian Hospice and ministered to hundreds of individuals in alcohol & drug recovery through programs such as Metro Atlanta Recovery Residences & Northstar Recovery. 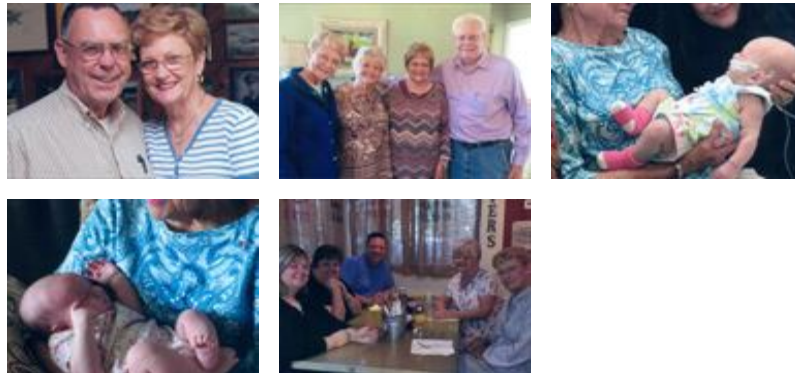
