She’s the smell of certain foods you remember, flowers you pick, the fragrance of life itself.*

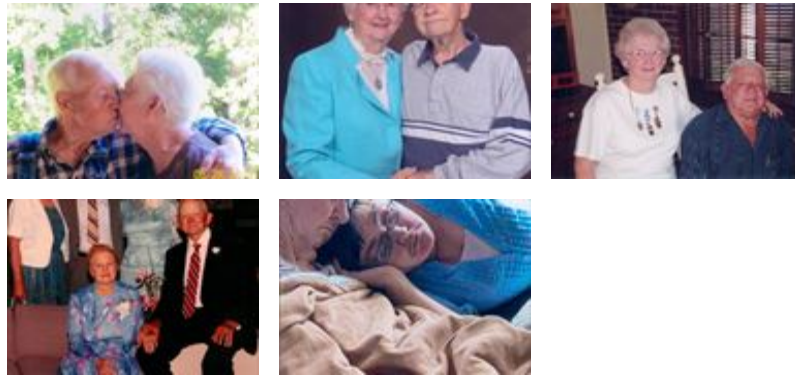
*She’s the cool hand on your brow when you’re not feeling well.
