Ladora Preston Yates Vaughn, 92, of Tyrone, GA passed away on October 6, 2014. She was born on October 8, 1922 in Lynchburg, VA. Mrs. Vaughn worked for the Tennessee Valley Authority in Knoxville, TN followed by a long career in the telephone industry, first with Telephone Answering Service, then as executive assistant to the President of Contact, Inc. in Charlotte, NC.
