



## Lanelle Plymal Lane

April 28, 1929 - September 7, 2024

Lanelle Plymal Lane, born on April 28, 1929, in Cedar Springs, Georgia, passed away peacefully, at Northside Hospital, on September 7, 2024, at the age of 95.

Lanelle graduated as the valedictorian of her class in 1946 and later pursued an Associate's Degree in Criminal Justice from Clayton Junior College. 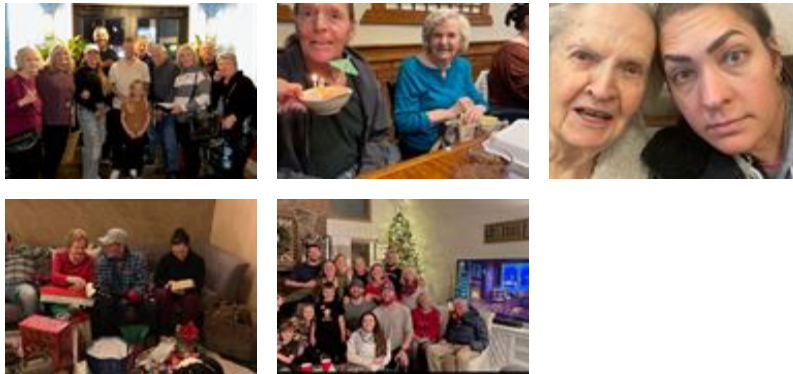
