She was a dedicated church member and served in many positions in her home church, Hopewell United Methodist in Tyrone, which her grandparents Samuel and Ella Ellison helped to start in the mid 1850's.

She loved spending time with her nieces and nephews. She taught them about life and what it meant to live simply and faithfully.

Lucy was one of 5 children and preceded in death by brothers Sam (Floy),

Marvin (Christine), and Calvin Ellison and brother-in-law Gary Hubbard. She is survived by her sister, Sandra Hubbard of Brooks and sister-in-law Marie Ellison of Tyrone along with multiple nieces and nephews.

We would get a laugh at the fact that she would move her car out from under the carport when it rained.
