



Marcus Lee Long Jr.

April 10, 1925 - January 26, 2025

Marcus “Lee” Long, Jr., a devoted family man, veteran, and respected member of his community, passed away peacefully on January 26, 2025, in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. Born on April 10, 1925, in College Park, Georgia, Lee lived a life marked by service, dedication, and love. He was 99 years old at the time of his passing.

Lee proudly served his country as a member of the United States Navy, where he participated in the Pacific Theatre during World War II. Following his honorable service, he embarked on a long and fulfilling career with Delta Airlines, retiring after 42 years of dedicated work. Lee was also a 70 year member of The Masonic Lodge.

An avid golfer, Lee found joy and camaraderie on the greens. His faith was an integral part of his life; he was a cherished member of Southwest Christian Church in Newnan, Georgia, and previously worshiped at First Christian Church of Tyrone. A funeral service to honor Lee's life will be held on Sunday, February 2, 2025, at 3:00 PM at First Christian Church of Tyrone, with Gary Boyd and James White officiating. The family will receive friends at the church prior to the service from 1:00 PM until 3:00 PM. Interment will follow at Forest Lawn Memorial Gardens.

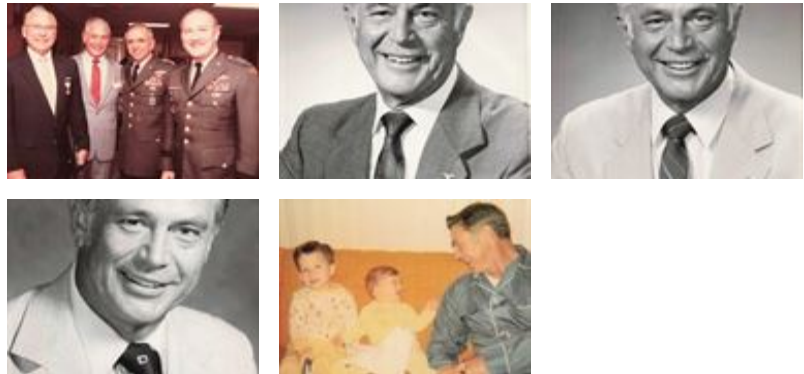

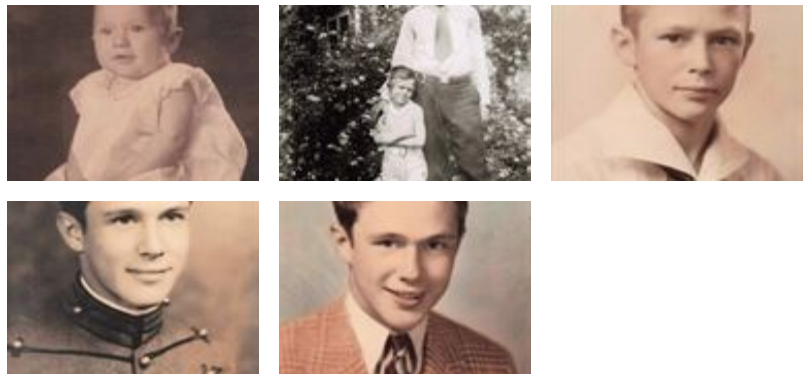
