Patricia Sue Jenner Harbin was born on July 30, 1950, in Highland, IL to Gordon and Maxine Jenner. She grew up in Decatur, IL with her older brother, Mike. Pat attended MacArthur High School where she used her remarkable soprano voice to lead musical productions such as *The Sound of Music*. She graduated in 1968, and decided to further her education at Lincoln Christian College focusing on music. She sang in the Gloria Choir and played the role of Dolly Levi in *Hello, Dolly*. It was at Lincoln that she met and fell in love with a southerner named Mike Harbin. Pat and Mike were married on June 5, 1971. They had dreams of a big family and were blessed with 5 children. They loved the Lord and devoted their 45 years of marriage to serving Him through church ministry and mission work. In her 66 years on earth she lead choirs great and small, taught children to read at The Bedford School, sewed beautiful outfits, and made the best biscuits you'll ever eat. She loved to travel and loved people. Her family was her heart. She was preceded in death by her parents Gordon and Maxine Jenner and her, mother-in-law Carolyn Harbin and granddaughter, Caroline. Pat is survived by her beloved husband Mike; her 5 children and their spouses; Elizabeth (Ken) Miles, Becky (Mike) Marion, Sarah (Jason) Westbrook, Abby (Pete) Dockery, John (Kara) Harbin; and her 18 precious grandchildren; Zach, Kyrie, Cody, Joey, Reagan, Jackson, John, Eden, Charlotte, Ezra, Solomon, Samuel, June, Sarah, Abigail, Christian, Elliott, and Hazel; and her Father-in-law Robert Harbin.
