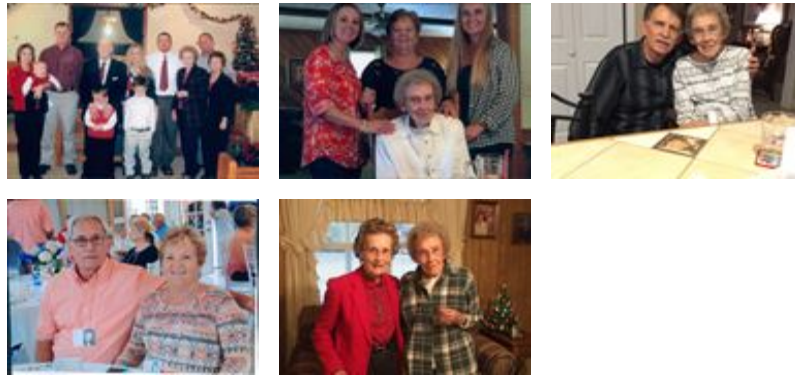
“ *Phil and Sue,*
