



## Phillip Hampton Sims

Phillip Hampton Sims passed peacefully on Friday February 7th, 2025, at his home.

Phillip (Phil) was born in 1956 in Forest Park, Georgia to the late H.B. Sims and Theresa Staples Sims. The family moved to Tyrone, Georgia in 1966, and put down roots on a gorgeous farm. His profound passion for the outdoors was cultivated while working on his family farm. He later went on to graduate from Berry College with a Degree in Marine Biology.

After college he opened a family business, S&S Glass in Tyrone and served the community at College Park Fire Department. Phil was a fireman for 26 years, retiring in 2007.
