Ralph Wilson Ferguson, Jr., age 82, passed away on April 15, 2026, fittingly on tax day, as if to remind us all of his accounting roots one last time.

Born on April 8, 1944, in Atlanta, GA, Ralph grew up in Nebraska where his father served in the United States Air Force and his mother was a homemaker.

Ralph proudly served his country in the United States Air Force. He was drafted in 1965 and was honorably discharged in 1969. During his service, he was stationed in Germany and served as a linguist. After his military service he returned to Georgia where he continued his studies at Georgia State University.

Ralph built a commendable career in the field of finance and accounting.
