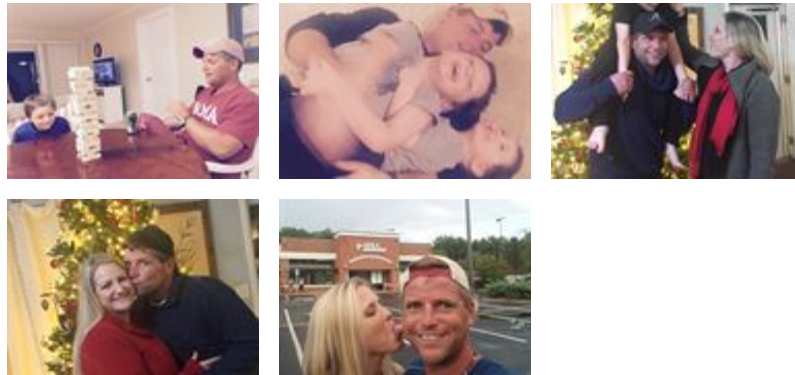

Josh had crazy charisma! We would be out and id meet a group of people talk to them for awhile, and go find Josh to tell him I just met some cool folks come meet them. Well hell, Josh had already met them, had their phone #s, street addresses, emails and was FB, Snapchat, Instagram friends and had been invited to their parent's house for supper.

So time moves on. I got re-married, new job, new house, all those things that swiftly move you through a year. Josh went into the movie business and worked every hour of every day it seemed. We stayed in contact but I have not seen Josh in about a year. Yet a

*few times a month he would reach out and we would make tentative plans to get together and catch up. He wanted me to meet his new girlfriend really bad, kept telling me how wonderful she was. But something always came up. Its unfortunate. Just goes to show you need to make time for the special people in your life bc just like that they could be gone. I never imagined I wouldn't have another chance to see him. I always thought he'd be a couple miles down the road on the farm.*

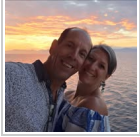
