



Rebecca "Becky" Brown

October 12, 1928 - October 11, 2022

Rebecca Hunt Brown, 94, passed away after a brief illness on 10/12/2022. At the time, she was a resident of Stonehenge Senior Living.

Becky was born in Reo, Georgia on October 12th 1928. After graduating from the University of Georgia, she was a teacher for a few years in Trion, Georgia. She then went on to marry Tom Brown Jr., and they moved to Atlanta, Georgia. She started raising her two children, Tommy and Taska. She began working for Fulton County as a first-grade teacher; she ended her career as principal of Evelyn C. West Elementary in Fairburn, Georgia.

After retirement, she bought Settlers Antiques in Blairsville, Georgia, where she lived part-time, while keeping her house in College Park. She then moved to Blairsville full time after the death of her husband in 2010.

Becky was an antiques dealer for many years and had a booth at the Don Scott Antique Show. She thoroughly enjoyed running her antique shop and making new friends who began as regular customers. She was always hunting for treasures for her shop at thrift shops and local garage and estate sales.

She was a longtime member of the First Baptist Church of Blairsville. She was devoted to her family and always tried to send them home with something to eat! She was famous for her cheese biscuits. She was generous with her time and supported those in need. She was an avid card player.

She is preceded in death by her husband Tom, her daughter Taska, sister Jane, and brother Jim Tom. She is survived by her son Tommy (Chris),

grandchildren Ryan (Taryn) Brown and Melissa Brown; great-grandchildren Taylor Costine, Jake Parks, Cooper, Salem, and Truitt Brown.

Services will be held at the chapel of Parrott Funeral Home on October 24th at 11 o'clock. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service. The committal service will take place immediately following the service at Forest Lawn Memorial Gardens.

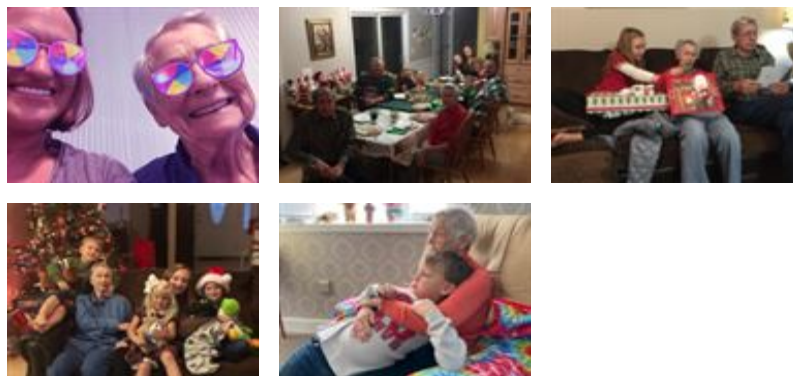
