



Robert (Bob) Allen

April 16, 1924 - February 19, 2020

Mr. Robert (Bob) Allen, age 95, of Sharpsburg, passed away February 19, 2020. He was born on April 16, 1924 and raised on a farm in Pike County. During WWII he performed B-29 aviation repairs on the Island of Guam which later propelled him into a career at Delta Air Lines as a machinist in 1947. After a 42 year career he retired as Manager of Delta's Tooling and Ground Equipment Department and became a Delta Pioneer. He was an active long-time member of the First Baptist Church of College Park and later became a member of Palmetto Baptist Church. He also served on the Canongate Village Homeowner's Association Board as treasurer for many years.

Mr. Allen was preceded in death by his wife of sixty-three years, Martha Brock Allen, of College Park and later by his second wife of three years, Ann Matthiessen Allen of Brunswick. He is survived by his children, Susan (Duane) Hutchison of Sharpsburg, and Scott Allen of Peachtree City, his sister, Jeanette Adams, four grandsons, Garry (Morgan) Hutchison of Sharpsburg, David Hutchison of Avondale Estates, Ross (Nicole) Hutchison of Canton, Robby (Emilie) Allen of Peachtree City, and four great grandchildren, Palmer, AnaLee, Emma Hutchison, and Graysie Jo Barfiled.

A memorial service will be held at Parrott's Funeral Home on Wednesday, February 26, 2020 at 2:00 PM with Dr. Jimmy Orr officiating. The family will receive guests one hour before the service. A private family interment will be

held at Forest Lawn Cemetery in College Park.

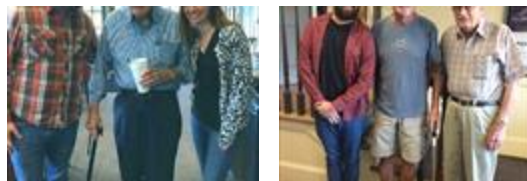
