Rest easy soldier until we meet again...SEMPER Fi...

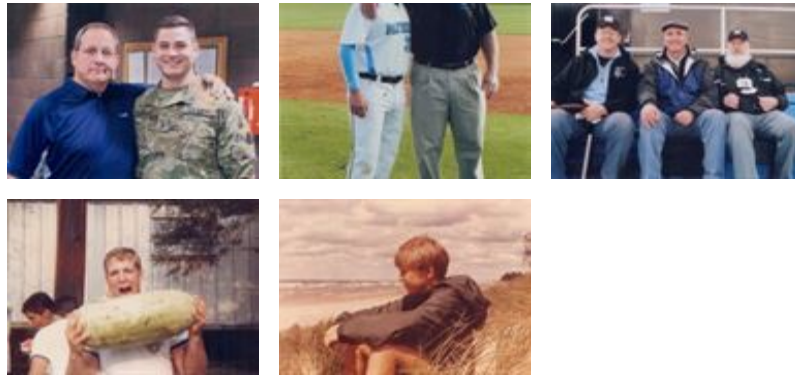
