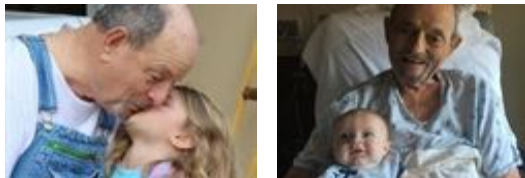
I could not have loved a brother more than I love him. I will miss him all the rest of my life until I see him again.
