Robert Wilmirth Wilson, 93, of Newnan, GA, formerly of College Park, GA went to be with Jesus on August 3, 2014 at Savannah Court of Newnan. He was born, April 23, 1921, in Lawrence County, PA to Clyde Gilmore and Mary Viola Johnston Wilson. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two brothers, Arthur Johnston and Russell Clyde, and a sister Bertha Elizabeth Wilson Rogers.

Robert grew up on a dairy farm along the Neshannock River in Volant, PA. Following graduation from Eastbrook High School he was drafted into the army where he served in the Army Air Corps as a gunner on an A-26 Invader during WW II. Following the war he married Harriette Jane McGary of New Castle, PA. and accepted a job with Delta Air Lines as a maintenance inspector. He worked in Miami for 6 months before being transferred to Atlanta where he spent the remainder of his career with Delta. He loved sports and enjoyed coaching Little League baseball and watching his sons play sports at the high school and collegiate levels. He also served on the College Park City Council as a Councilman for many years.

The funeral will be Tuesday, August 5, 2014 at 10 o'clock in the Chapel of Parrott Funeral Home in Fairburn, GA. Visitation will be held one hour prior to the service on Tuesday.
