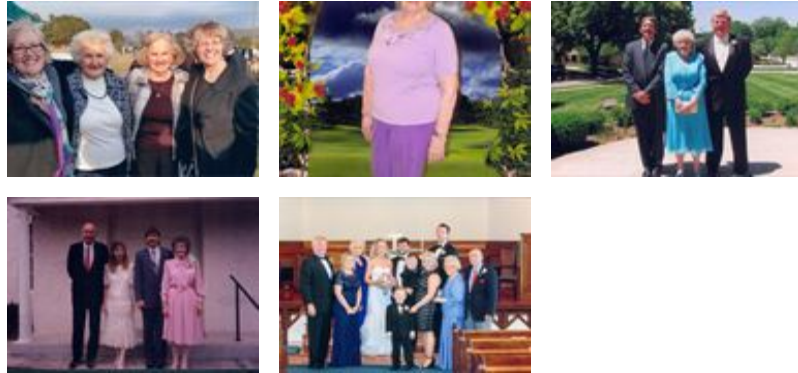

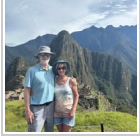

About four years ago, I went to play Bingo and have a fish fry with Sarah and her friends. Sarah sure had a lot of friends. I enjoyed meeting them and playing Bingo with her.

Sarah and I always met at Red Lobster around Christmas time when I was on break. We would talk for about two hours. I will miss all Sarah's stories and her Momma's sayings.

Sarah loved and missed Joe so much. She loved her boys, their

spouses, grands, and her siblings. Sarah was smart and funny. I will miss my friend.
