Sarah Watson, 92, of Union City, Georgia passed away peacefully on April 12, 2021 at Southwest Christian Care in Union City.

Sarah worked as a bookkeeper at Sears & Roebuck on Ponce de Leon Avenue in Atlanta immediately out of high school. After marrying Jesse, Sarah was a loving mother and homemaker. Through the years, they lived in Atlanta, Palmetto, Lithia Springs and Union City. She owned and operated the bait shop at Sweetwater Creek State Park from 1973 to 1978.

Sarah enjoyed cooking for her family, putting up vegetables from the garden, tending her flower garden, volunteering as a Candy Striper at South Fulton

Hospital and attending Friendship Baptist Church. She was a voracious reader and had a wicked sense of humor. Her greatest joy in life was taking care of her babies.

She is preceded in death by her parents; brothers Henry Burson and Max Burson; and son William Robert (Bob).
