Sharon loved worshiping with her church family at Tri-County Baptist Church in Senoia as well as at Victory Baptist Church in Palmetto where she and William attended when there were no services at Tri-County or the drive to Senoia was prohibited due to the weather or early sunset in winter. Missions conferences and guest preachers that she knew from her days at Tennessee Temple University were some of her favorite times to be at Tri-County. She also had a special place in her heart for Deaf people and was used by God to tell them about her Jesus by learning sign language and interpreting worship to provide accessibility to Deaf men, women, and children. Her most recent students were high schoolers at Newnan Christian School, run by Bible Baptist Church.

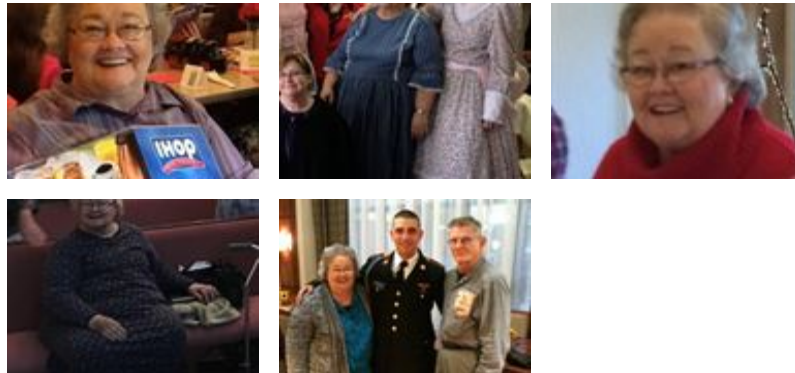

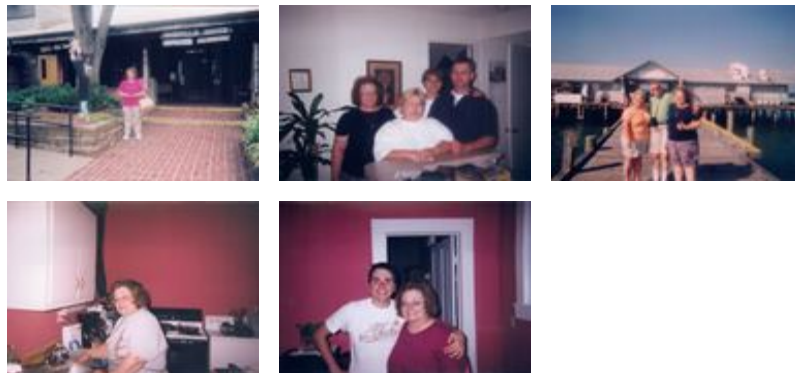
