



Rev. Tom Gullatt

Rev. Tom D. Gullatt, 91 of Palmetto was called to his Heavenly Home on November 15, 2011. Rev. Gullatt, formerly of Fairburn, but more recently residing in the Baptist Manor in Palmetto. He and his first wife, Mary Studdard Gullatt spent 35 years as missionaries to Japan under the auspices of the International Mission Board, SBC, retiring in 1985. After retirement they returned for short assignments there. During their term of service their special assignment was in church planting in a city where there was only one other church. Rev. Gullatt was preceded in death by his parents, Dow and Maie Gullatt of Palmeto, and his first wife, Mary Studdard Gullat, the latter having passed away after a long battle with cancer. He is survived by his present wife Vera Campbell Gullatt who was also a missionary to Japan and a native of Fairburn; daughter, Miriam Parkerson and her husband Bill of Edmond, OK; son, John Gullatt and his wife Kiyoko of Tokyo, Japan; sisters-in-law, Allene Gullatt; Bertha Harris; grandchildren, Michael Taylor, Derek and Julie Taylor, Erika and Daniel Ptak, and Monika Gullatt; great grandchildren, Shea, Maya, Olivia and Ella.
