Mr. Vincent McKeever (Vinnie) Rossetti of Peachtree City passed away January 10, 2017. He was preceded in death by his father, Vincent Michael Rossetti and grandfather, Vincent Francis Rossetti. He is survived by his mother, Pamela Orr Rossetti; sisters, Rebecca Michelle Rossetti and Natalie Christine Rossetti; grandparents, Constance Quinn Rossetti, Dorothy Springer Orr and John McKeever Orr; and many aunts, uncles, cousins and extended family members.
